Policing Standardisation Event for Assessors and IQAs

SFJ Awards are pleased to be holding a rolling programme of themed workshop events for assessors and IQAs involved in the delivery, assessment and IQA of selected SFJ Awards qualification suites.

These events are designed to:

- standardise the approach of SFJ Awards centres
- network with other centres offering the same/similar qualification suites
- share good practice
- provide a forum for discussion.

The event will comprise of a short “good practice” training session and information input followed by standardisation activities.

The events will help to assist differentiation agreement between attainment levels and a consistent approach to sufficiency of evidence.

Please Note: Places are limited to *a maximum of 34 per event*, therefore initially we will limit places to one representative per centre. Attendance is free. Cancellation or non-attendance *on the day* will incur a charge of £30 to cover administration and other costs. If a substitute representative attends in place of the registered attendee, no charge will be levied.

Attendance is particularly important to centres with Direct Claims Status for these qualifications.

Pre-Event Preparation: Attendees will be expected to bring along some sanitised/anonymised samples of learner evidence and associated assessor and IQA documentation, to be perused during the event.

- If samples seen on the day have not been sanitised/anonymised, attendees must respect **confidentiality**
- The ethos of the event is to be **supportive** and not critical
- It is hoped that exemplars and items of best practice can be highlighted as well as areas for improvement
