Apprenticeship Funding Example Quietest Station

On-Call firefighter 1 call a week (52 calls year)

Expect an On-Call firefighter to achieve 50% of calls (26 calls year/ 26 paid hours)

26 x 4 years = 104 hrs

562 – 104 = 458 additional hrs required to achieve apprenticeship 9.5 hours / Month (one operational shift)

Dev Rate £11.51 x 458 = £5,271.58 + employers contribution

Apprenticeship funding £14000.00 less 20% EPA cost would off-set this additional cost

£11,200.00 funding to pay for apprenticeship training
