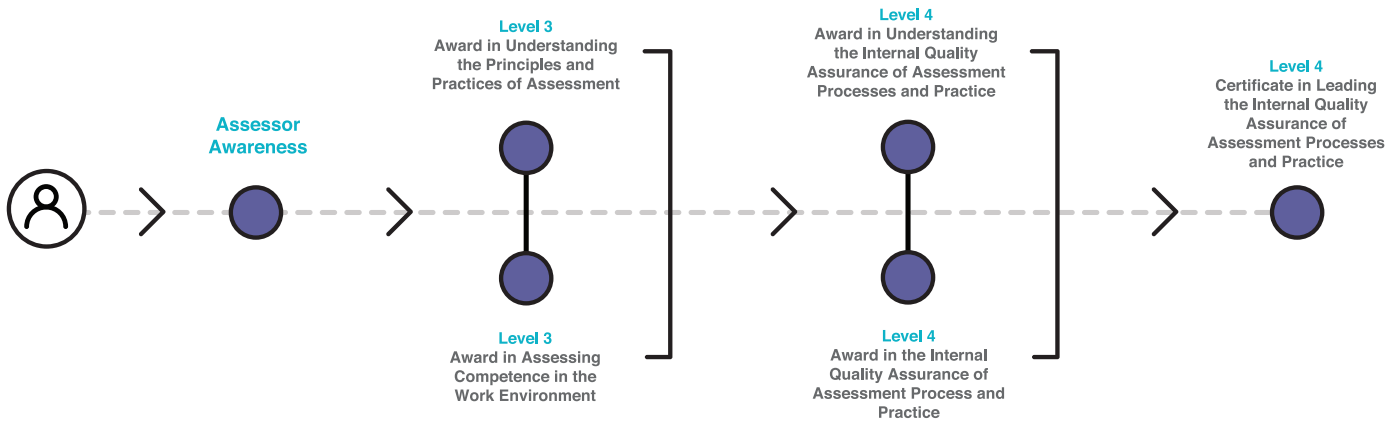
How are our qualifications delivered?
